The days for school attendance in Department of Education schools each week during the term will be from **Monday to Friday** unless **otherwise** directed by the Department of Education.

Hours of attendance for pupils shall be from **9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** provided, however, that there shall be a daily recess of one or more periods, which shall not in aggregate exceed one hour.

Morning Registration for schools shall be from 9:00 a.m. – 9:10 a.m. Students will be considered late when they arrive later than 9:10 a.m. (i.e., after Morning Registration has ended).

Working hours for **teachers** shall be from **8:45 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.** inclusive of the lunch hour and as may otherwise be required for the purpose of staff meetings, administrators and subject coordinators meetings, curriculum development meetings, etc.

Working hours for **teachers’ aides** shall be from **8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**, inclusive of one (1) hour for lunch break.

Working hours for school **administrators** shall be from **8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** inclusive of one (1) hour for lunch break.

STAFF MEETINGS (Faculty)

Staff Meetings are held once per month (usually on the **third or fourth Wednesday** in the month) at **2:00 p.m.** Students are to be dismissed at 1:45 p.m. Dates are stipulated monthly. See dates on pages 3 to 5.

STAFF MEETINGS (Support)

Staff Meetings are held once per month (usually on the **third or fourth Thursday** in the month) at **9:30 a.m.** for one hour. Dates are stipulated monthly. See dates on pages 3 to 5.

PTA MEETINGS

PTA Meetings are held once per month usually during the **fourth week** in the month at 6:30 p.m.: **Monday** (Stand-Alone Pre-Primary Schools); **Tuesday** (Primary Schools); **Wednesday** (Junior High Schools) and **Thursday** (Senior High Schools). Schools with grades 7 to 12 may hold meetings on Wednesday and/or Thursday. All-age schools can hold their meetings on any of the four days. See dates on pages 3 to 5. Family Island Districts will coordinate meetings according to the bussing schedule.

NATIONAL EXAMINATIONS - Grade Level Assessment Tests (**GLAT**), Bahamas Junior Certificate (**BJC**) and Bahamas General Certificate of Secondary Education (**BGCSE**)

GLAT are usually administered in the month of May to students in the third and sixth grades. Third and sixth grade students will report to school as usual and sit examinations during specified times during the school day.

BJC EXAMINATIONS (PRACTICAL AND THEORY) usually begin in April and end in June.

Ninth grade students will remain at home during the BJC THEORY EXAMINATIONS, and will only report to school, in full uniform, to sit registered examinations. Ninth grade students will report to school for regular classes after the BJC Theory Examinations are completed.

All other students (8th, 10th, and 11th graders), who have registered to sit BJC Examinations, must remain in school for the exams and attend regular classes when they are not sitting exams.

BGCSE EXAMINATIONS (PRACTICAL AND THEORY) usually begin in March/April and end in June.

The final day for twelfth grade students shall be the day prior to the sitting of the first major (over half of the Grade 12 registered) THEORY BGCSE EXAMINATION. Students will only return to school, in full uniform, to sit registered examinations or attend Graduation Rehearsal Sessions.

All other students (10th and 11th graders) who have registered to sit BGCSE Examinations are to remain in school for the duration of the examinations and attend regular classes when they are not sitting examinations.

SPORTS

INTERHOUSE SPORTS MEET - Competitions should not extend beyond two days during the months of January or February by individual primary and secondary schools in New Providence, Grand Bahama and the Family Islands. All students and teachers are expected to participate by attending the event and supporting as needed. This event usually takes place on the school campus and/or at an appropriate facility away from the school campus. Only one full day that interrupts the Instructional Programme is permitted. During Field Events Day, there should be regular classes for non-athletes.

INTERSCHOOL DISTRICT SPORTS MEET –PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS (Grand Bahama and Family Islands)

Such competitions are held for two days during the second term. Student athletes and selected teachers are expected to participate by attending the event and supporting as needed. This event usually takes place on a school campus in the District or at an appropriate community facility.

GSSSA TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS (New Providence)

Competitions should not be held for more than three days, usually in the month of February or March, at the Thomas A. Robinson Stadium.

Attendees:

- Day 1: Junior and Senior High School Athletes; selected Coaches and Teachers;
- Day 2: Opening Ceremony; All Junior High School Athletes and Coaches; Senior High School Athletes and selected Coaches and Teachers; all Junior High School Students and Teachers;
- Day 3: Senior High School Athletes and Coaches only; all Senior High Schools Students and Teachers.

NPPSSA TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS (New Providence)

Competitions should not be held for more than three days during March or April. Primary School Student athletes and selected teachers are expected to participate by attending the event and supporting as needed. This event usually takes place at the Thomas A Robinson Stadium.


FUN DAY – Two fun days are allowed per school year. Fun days are usually held the day before the Mid-Term Break in October and February. Fun Days dates cannot be changed unless written permission is obtained from the Director. Apart from Fun Days, schools must receive permission from the Director for “Out of Uniform” days.
